

2026 Summer Shootout Legend Car and Bandolero Car TIRE RULES

- Each (B, O, Y, S, M, P) driver pre-registered for the CMS Summer Shootout will be allotted 6 new Hoosier tires with nubs to start the 2026 CMS Summer Shootout. These tires must be used at the CMS Summer Shootout. **These tires must be impounded within one week of pickup or delivery and will be held at CMS until after the last race of the Summer Shootout (regardless of your first race date).** A driver that registers & gets 6 CMS Summer Shootout tires and does not run a minimum of 4 Summer Shootout races will be penalized by INEX (EIRI).
- Each (B, O, Y, S, M, P) driver pre-registered for the CMS Summer Shootout will have the option of purchasing and using 2 new tires after week 4 (6/24 – 6/26). These 2 new tires will be swapped with 2 of your 6 tires in your inventory (to maintain an inventory of 6 tires) AND Each (B,O,Y,S,M,P) driver pre-registered for the CMS Summer Shootout will have the option of purchasing and using 2 new tires after week 7 (7/8 – 7/10). These 2 new tires will be swapped with 2 of your 6 tires in your inventory (to maintain an inventory of 6 tires).
- If you purchase the additional tires (2 after week 4 / 2 after week 7), you must check in / swap out these tires on the following dates, during the following times:
6/29 – 11:30am till 1pm
7/13 – 4pm till 6pm
- Each tire will be recorded by INEX officials, to each driver, prior to delivery/pickup. Tires will be marked with a barcode / brand (registered to each driver) and will not be allowed to be used on other cars during the CMS Summer Shootout (EIRI).
- These tires can be used at any time (practice or racing) at CMS during the Summer Shoot Out. **THESE TIRES ARE FOR SUMMER SHOOTOUT AT CMS ONLY! Do not use these tires at other racetracks prior to the Summer Shootout!**
- There will be **NO PHYSICAL ALTERATIONS ALLOWED TO TIRES PRIOR TO, OR DURING THE CMS SUMMER SHOOTOUT.** Any marked Summer Shootout tire found with physical alterations (including during practice) will be confiscated and that driver will be penalized. Each tire found to have physical alterations will result in a \$100.00 fine and loss of all practice time during that drivers next event and that driver must start at the rear of their feature for the next event.
- **PHYSICAL ALTERATIONS are defined as:** Anything that changes the outer surface of the tire other than the racing surface and/or inner surface as delivered from Hoosier. **IN OTHER WORDS, NO CUTTING, BUFFING, SANDING, CAMBERING, SOAKING, SCRAPING, OR ANYTHING YOU CAN THINK OF! DO NOT PLAY GAMES WITH TIRES, YOU WILL LOSE THEM!**

- Competitors are allowed to use different, non-Summer Shootout marked Hoosier tires for practice if they choose. This is for practice only. 2026 CMS Summer Shootout marked tires must be used during all 2026 CMS Summer Shootout competition.
- If a Summer Shootout marked tire is damaged during on track events, drivers will use their “spare” Summer Shootout marked tires for replacement for the next event. Used INEX legal tires can be used for damaged / hot pit replacements during the main events (these tires will be allowed for the remainder of that race only, they will not become part of your inventory).
- Penalties will be issued for any tire damaged on purpose. Also, If INEX determines that a tire was damaged on purpose (with the intent of “swapping” that tire) it will be considered a physical alteration (the penalties for physical alterations will apply).
- Drivers registering after round 1 of the 2026 CMS Summer Shootout, will only be allowed to purchase 4 new Summer Shootout marked tires (registered to that driver). These new, with nubs, marked, Hoosier tires must be checked in with John Kelly before any practice or competition. These drivers are not eligible to purchase the additional new tires (for their inventory) after round 4 & 7.
- It is the drivers responsibility to make sure they have the proper tires on the car with the proper markings during all competition.
- In summary, Once CMS Summer Shootout tires are marked and registered to a driver, they can be used for Summer Shoot Out practice and competition only. **DO NOT TOUCH YOUR TIRES IN ANY WAY SHAPE OR FORM** and you will not have any tech issues.
- Damaged rims can be replaced at the track. John Kelly must approve any other arrangements.

Beginner Bandolero and Charger Legends Tire Rules

- Beginner Bandolero and Charger Legends competitors will use Hoosier tires legal to the INEX rulebook.
- If you start the Summer Shootout in the Beginner Bandolero or Charger Legends class, you must stay in that class for the duration of the 2026 CMS Summer Shootout.
- The exception to this rule will be, any driver that wins three races in the Beginner Bandolero or Charger Legends class must move to their respective INEX classes. At that point, INEX Officials will mark the tires used during the (3rd win) race & those tires must be used for the remainder of the 2026 CMS Summer Shootout.
